Hubbard, Wm. R., died Oct. 26, 1872, age 54y 11m 18d

Snethen, Albert, died July 12, 1863, age 1y 1m 25d, son of William and L.

Snethen, Annie J., Oct. 3, 1869 - Mar. 4, 1922, wife of William J., nee Dixon

Snethen, David S., May 28, 1833 - Feb. 24, 1899, son of William and Lorinda

Snethen, Elizabeth L., Jan. 6, 1840 - Jan. 21, 1914

Snethen, Emma E., died Jan. 6, 1863, age 18y 5m 30d, daughter of Wm. and L.

Snethen, Francis, July 20, 1855 - May 1, 1876, son of William and L.

Snethen, Lorinda, July 21, 1813 - Dec. 16, 1894, wife of William

Snethen, Prudence, Mar. 27, 1842 - Feb. 21, 1899, daughter of William and Lorinda

Snethen, Sally A., died Sept. 19, 1815, age 7y 10m 13d, daughter of Wm. and L.

Snethen, Susan G., died June 16, 1871, age 21y 10m 18d, daughter of William and L.

Snethen, William J., Sept. 13, 1852 - July 9, 1920

Snethen, Wm. S., Apr. 24, 1812 - June 5, 1890
