South of I-70 on State Highway 19; go 7.5 miles to State Road K; turn right; go 6 miles to State Road P about 5/10 of a mile; turn South on Bluffton Road #228. Go about 3 miles to burial site. Property Owned by Larry Korman. Per cemetery records, Montgomery County, Montgomery City, MO, section 1, page 45.

Baker Burial, New Florence, 1 memorial, Per records from the Montgomery County Historical Society, Montgomery City, MO. Section 23, Township 48 North, R 5 West. Block 16 original town of New Florence going South on Main Street turn across railroad tracks at first crossing. Go 3 blocks. Take Right turn on 2nd Street and Lackland. Andrew Johnson owner of property 2006.

Ellis Cemetery, Big Spring, 19 memorials, cemetery is 5.8 miles north of flashing light in Hermann on Highway 19. It is located 900 feet due east of Highway 19 in the trees just past the field.

Ferguson-Holland Cemetery, Montgomery, County, 11 memorials, 1/2 mile west of Jonesburg, MO on Hwy Y

Fine Cemetery, Montgomery County, 17 memorials, Camp Branch

First Baptist Church Cemetery, Montgomery County, 0 memorials, NE 1/4 of SEC 28 T2P 47 N R 5 W , Hwy 19 and Rt J, north of house on corner

Freeland Burial Ground, Big Spring, 8 memorials, East of Big Spring off Hwy Y to Cedar Knoll Lane. SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 SEC 34 T2P 47 N R 5 W

Gentry Burials, Lower Loutre Township, Bigspring, 6 memorials, Lower Loutre Township, from Bigspring, Montgomery County Missouri take Highway K. to property owned by Gentry. SE1/4 of NW1/4 SEC.30 T2N 47N R5W.

Gentry Cemetery, Montgomery County, 30 memorials, from Interstate 70 take New Florence, MO. exit. Go south on Hwy 19 to Big Spring. At Big Spring, turn right onto Hwy K. Follow Hwy K to Leach Branch Rd. Turn left onto Leach Branch Rd.(gravel) and go approximately 1.2 miles to Box # 289 on the right. The cemetery is in a field on private property approximately 1/2 mile from Leach Branch Rd.

A, from stoplight in Montgomery City, MO, go South on State Highway 161 to Danville, MO, cross viaduct over Interstate 70 to South Service Road to Mineola. Continue West on "N" 3.6 miles. Cross viaduct going North. Turn South on Deer Run Road and go to first house

Gregory Cemetery, Montgomery County, 37 memorials, located on Highway 40, west of Danville, Missouri, aka as Danville - Gregory Cemetery (this was in the notes by a user, and not noted AKA by findagrave)

Gregory Family Cemetery, Americus, 1 memorial, Township 46N-Range 6W-Section 6, located west of Americus, Missouri and north of Bluffton, Missouri. It is located just inside the Montgomery County boundary line, on private property (formerly owned by James Harrison Gregory in the 1800's). No access. Only one headstone found, with field stones marking other graves. Most information submitted by the Callaway County cemetery researchers

Haile Talbot Cemetery, McKittrick, 10 memorials, From Junction of Highways 19 and 94 near McKittrick, Mo., go about 1/2 mile west on Highway 94, to Hebner Road/County Rd 310. Turn right. (north) Take the private driveway that is about .4 mile

Harris Burials #1, Americus, 3 memorials, South of I 70, west on K then right HH. Located on Snethen Rd

Harris Burials #2, Montgomery County, 22 memorials, located on a farm owned by Walter Higgenbotham, Sr.

Hartman Family Cemetery, Americus, 4 memorials, NE 1/4 of Sec 15 Twp 46 N R 6 W . On John Hartman farm about 3 miles south of Americus. South of I 70 on Hwy 19, go 7.5 miles to K hwy. Go 6.1 miles to P hwy, go about 1 1/2 mile to Allgeyer Lake on right, then turn on next right on gravel road. There is sign 'Lone Tree Lake Estates', go left up hill. Cemetery under tree near new home. Info from Montgomery County Cemetery Records

Hatton-Myers Farm Graveyard, High Hill, 3 memorials, Writing in 1934, Jonah and Signey Hatton's youngest child, Emma Virginia Hatton Goodrich, in reference to her mother states, "Sidney died August 5, 1880. She, my father and sister Lucinda Culpepper lie buried on my Mother's old farm in Montgomery Count, Missouri. The farm is now owned by Charles Myers." In the 1860 US Census, the Hatton family resided near Loutre, with a post office at Big Spring. The exact location of the Hatton Cemetery is not known.

Hays Burying Ground, Wellsville, 4 memorials, Cemetery is located between Montgomery City and Wellsville, Missouri in S15, T49N, R6W.

Henderson-Clark Burials, Americus, 6 memorials, SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Section 29 Township 47N Range 6W. Extreme south part. From Interstate 70 (New Florence exit) go south on state Hwy 19 for 7.5 miles. At Big Spring turn right on Hwy K. Go 5.5 miles turn right on HH. Continue to county road #284 Overkamp Road. Go 1.1 miles. Stone about 1/4 mile SW of county road #284 on private property.

Henze Burial Site, Montgomery County, 1 memorial, SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec 1 Twp 46 N Range 5 W . South of Hwy I 70 on Hwy 19, 8.8 miles , turn left on county road # 306, go 1.5 miles will cross creek with big tin whistle. Go short distance, will see on left /east side crest of Hill is burial site. Private Property. info from Montgomery County Missouri Cemetery Records

Hodapp Family Cemetery, Montgomery City, 2 memorials, SW 1/4 SEC 29 TWP 49N R3W

Holiness Church Cemetery (aka Holiness Church Mission Cemetery, Holiness Mission Cemetery), Bellflower, 5 memorials, Mission Cemetery S/W 1/4 of SE 1/4 SEC 19 TWP 49 N R 3 W, E N E of Montgomery City.

On property owned by William Mulligan 2006 from stoplight in Montgomery City, go South HWY 19 8/10 MI to Long Road. Turn East (Left) go 1.8 MI to 204 Long Rd. South Side of Road Burials are South of House.

Hugo Cemetery, New Florence, 227 memorials

Hunter Cemetery #1, Montgomery County, 104 memorials, Northwest of Americus on Oscar Weibring Farm - current owner Donald Houska of Rhineland, MO; Located in southern Montgomery County, near Callaway County line; Sect 34 Township 47 N. R6. This is off of Hwy HH; Directions from I-70 and Hwy 19: Go south about 7-8 miles to small town of Big Spring; go west on Hwy K approximately 8 miles to Hwy HH and then west about a mile. If you get to end of blacktop go back to first house (sets way back near woods) on left and cemetery is just before that on a hill. The cemetery isn't kept up, is overgrown, so best time to go would be spring or fall and you will have to walk at least 1/4 mile or more and then up a hill. Knox Family Cemetery, Montgomery County, 3 memorials, NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec 10 Twp 46 N R 6 W; south of I 70 on hwy 19 go 7.5 miles to K, go 6.1 miles to P , go left on Bluffton Rd to Bush Rd. county rd 294 ?

Leach Burial, Montgomery County, 1 memorial, SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec 6 Twp 48 N R 3 W

Leavell Burials, Montgomery County, 5 memorials, SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 SEC 22 TWP 46 N R 5 W; Stones moved to lawn of house, go south from I 70 for 14 miles on hwy 19 to hwy 94, turn right to 1045 hwy 94

Liberty Baptist Church Cemetery, Big Spring, 207 memorials, Liberty Baptist Church Cemetery:: NW1/4 of SE1/4 SEC 28 T47N R5W – from I-70 go South on St Hwy 19 East Side State Hwy 19 East side State HWY 19 about one/10 mile South of Big Spring City Limit Sign (Location and directions are courtesy of Montgomery County Historical Society.)

Logan Cemetery, Montgomery City, 5 memorials

Loutre Island Cemetery, McKittrick, 157 memorials, located along Hwy 19 before you get to Loutre Shore Country club and the town of McKittrick.

Loutre Lick Pioneer Cemetery, Montgomery County, 16 memorials

Lovlace Cemetery, Danville, 17 memorials, a.k.a. Fulkerson-Lovlace Cemetery; The November 16, 1900 Montgomery Tribune described this cemetery as neglected and dilapidated. Described as southwest corner of orchard that runs up within a couple hundred feet of the old courthouse; Land owner desires visitors to wait until after crops get harvested in the fall to visit.

Loyd - Brown Burials, 2 memorials, NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 SEC 27 T 48 N R 5 W; Maybe additional burials here ? Union Electric Power Line thru center of Cemetery

Mahone Family Burials, Wellsville, **0 memorials**, South of Wellsville at 305 Cemetery Road. NE 1/2 of SW 1/4 Sec 15 Twn 49 N Range 6 W, West across RR tracks from Sunrise Memorial Gardens; Only 3 government stones here

Mahoney Family Burials, Wellsville, 4 memorials, **appears to be the same as Mahone Family Burials**, directions are exactly the same; South of Wellsville at 305 Cemetery Road. NE 1/2 of SW 1/4 Sec 15 Twn 49 N Range 6 W, West across RR tracks from Sunrise Memorial Gardens; Only 3 government stones here

Martin Burial Site, Americus, 3 memorials, SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Section 29 Township 47N Range 6W. From Interstate 70(New Florence, MO. exit) go south on state Hwy 19 for 7.5 miles. At Big Spring turn right on Hwy K. Go 5.5 miles turn right on HH. Continue to county road #284 Overkamp Road. Go 8/10 mile. Burials about 50 yards north side of road on private property. No stones, only a wooden form with a plastic funeral home marker(no name is visible).

Maxey Burials, Rhineland, 3 memorials, north of Hwy 94 west of Rhineland

McComack Cemetery, Mineola, 27 memorials, The McComack Cemetery is located in Montgomery County Missouri, NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 Section 2, Township 47 N, Range 6W on private property off Turkey Ridge Road about one and one half miles south of Mineola. The cemetery has only six marked tombstones that identify seven individuals and the remaining graves are marked with flagstones set on edge. There are at least thirty-five recognizable gravesites. The earliest marked tombstone is dated 1878 and the most recent is dated 1944. The last known burial was for William Thomas Redman in 1946. Information from Montgomery County Historical Record

Mount Horeb Church and Cemetery, Danville Township, 183 memorials

Mount Olivet Cemetery (aka Conley Cemetery, Nettle Cemetery), Mineola, 115 memorials, Rural; NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 SECTION 20 Township 48N Range 6W. From Interstate 70 in Montgomery County, Missouri, take the Danville exit and go south to south outer road (Hwy J). Stay on J until reaching Mineola, then at the junction of J and N keep going straight for the road becomes Hwy N. Cross the bridge and stay on N for about 5 miles to Gerding Lane on the left. Their two room building is small and only open on Tuesday mornings unless you call ahead and make an appointment with her. School records are in the basement of the county court house in Montgomery City.
