Name: Name of every person who died during the year ending 1st June 1870, whose usual place of abode at the time of his death was in his family (column 2)

Age: Age of person in years unless otherwise indicated (column 3) D(ays) M(onths) W(eeks)

S: Sex, m(ale) f(emale) n(ot) l(isted)

Color: w(hite) b(lack) m(ulatto)

M/W: m(arried) w(idowed)

POB: Place of birth; Pru = Prussia; England = Eng; otherwise standard postal abbreviations were used for the states

F: Father of foreign birth

M: Mother of foreign birth

MTH: Month of death

Trade: Profession, occupation, or trade (column 11)

Cause: Cause of death; if blank, nothing was entered
