REAM, Daniel P., Private, Co. G, 157th Illinois Infantry, 15 Feb. 1864 to 15 Sept. 1864 (7 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Piles, discharged on surgeon's certificate.

RETALLICK, Catherine, Widow, RETALLICK, Francis, Private, Co.F, 122nd Ohio Infantry, 20 July 1862 to ____ (2 yr., 12 da.) P.O. Add: City of Wellsville, Mo. Remarks: Died July 8, 1864 at City Point, VA.

THOMPSON, Larkin A., Private, Co.I, 31st Missouri Infantry, 8 Aug. 1862, to 15 June 1863 (10 mo., 7 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Shot in abdomen. Suffering sight.

THOMPSON, Larkin A., Captain, 73rd Missouri Militia, 14 Mar. 1865 to 16 July 1865 (4 mo., 2 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Shot in abdomen. Suffering sight. (Same person as above)

BEALE, Henry G., Private, Co.F, 18th Mayerlang Infantry, 5 Mar. 1864 to 5 Nov. 1865 (1 yr., 6 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

SMITH, Levinia, Widow, SMITH, James A., Private, Co.H, 3rd Missouri Cavalry, 1 Mar. 1862 to 5 Feb. 1865 (2 yr., 11 mo., 4 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Rheumatism, in bad condition.

SMITH, Noah, Corporal, Co.F, 3rd Missouri Cavalry, 1 June 1862 to 5 Feb. 1865 (3 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Rheumatism.

WEISS, George, Private, Co. C, 49th Missouri Infantry, 3 Sept. 1864 to 2 Aug. 1865 (1 yr., 29 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Discharged on surgeon's certificate.

LOCKHART, Edward, alias Edward Pearl, Corporal, Co. G, 56th Missouri Infantry, Aug 1863 to June 1865 (1 yr., 6 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

SHEETS, Henry W., Corporal, Co.C, 30th Missouri Infantry, 20 Aug. 1862 to 25 Feb. 1863 (6 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

LOVE, William G., Private, Co. F, 21st Illinois Infantry, 23 June 1861 to 23 July 1864 (3 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Rheumatism, crippled in joints.

SWEAMINGEN, Thomas M., 1st Lieutenant, Co. B, 67th Missouri Cavalry, April 1862 to Dec. 1864 (3 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Kidney disease and diarrhea.

MOORHEAD, Rebecca, Widow. MOORHEAD, James J., Private, Co. A, 166th Ohio Infantry, 2 May 1864 to 14 Dec. 1864 (3 mo., 10 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

FRAIZER, William, Private, Co. D, ____ Missouri Cavalry, 15 April 1862 to ____ 1865 (3 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

SULIVAN, Daniel M., Lieutenant Colonel, 67th Missouri Militia, 30 Aug. 1862 to 11 June 1864 (2 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Injury in right hip.

CREW, John, Private, Co. F, 44th Ohio Infantry, 17 Aug. 1862 to 4 Nov. 1863 (1 yr., 2 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

HUDSON, Ellender, Widow. HUDSON, George, Private, Co. B, 99th Indiana Infantry, Aug. 1862 to June 1865 (3 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

McDONNELL, Francis, Private, Co. C, 71st Ohio Infantry, March 1861 to Jan. 1862 (1 yr., 11 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Broken arm, honorable discharge.

McDONNELL, Francis, Private, Co. C, 8th Ohio Cavalry, Sept. 1864 to March 1865 (1 yr., 9 mo.) Disability: Piles and rheumatism. remarks: In Libby Prison 3 months (Same person as above)

ARTTERBERRY, Thomas, Private, Co.D, 59th Illinois Infantry, 29 July 1861 to 17 Sept. 1864 (3 yr., 1 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

WOLF, Joseph, Corporal, Co.F, 2nd Missouri Light Artillery, 31 Mar. 1864 to 26 Aug. 1865 (1 yr., 5 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

KERR, John, Private, Co. B, 49th Missouri Infantry, 7 Aug. 1864 to 7 Aug. 1865 (1 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Chronic bronchitis, total disability.

KERR, Sophia, Widow. WILLIAMS, John A., Private, Co. D, 49th Missouri Infantry, 7 Aug. 1864 to 13 Mar 1865. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. remarks: Died at New Orleans, March 13, 1865.

BRADLEY, Matthew, Private, Co. C, 29th Missouri Infantry, Aug. 1862 to 1 Feb. 1863 (7 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Discharged on account of disability.

VOGT, John, Sergeant, Co.E, 24th Missouri State Militia Infantry, 10 Sept. 1862 to 10 June 1865 (3 yr., 4 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Shot in leg. Lamé at times.

ZEIGLER, Joseph A., Private, Co. F, 3rd Missouri cavalry, 12 June 1862 to 21 April 1866 (4 yr., 4 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Wound in left wrist.

WORLEY, Amos H., 1st Lieutenant, 8th Ohio Light Artillery, 25 Dec. 1861 to 5 Aug. 1865 (4 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Shot in left arm.

REED, Thomas, Private, Co.P, 31st Missouri infantry, 4 Aug. 1862 to 7 July 1865 (2 yr., 11 mo., 3 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Shot in left leg.

LEWIS, Christopher P., Private, Co. B, 49th Missouri Infantry, 4 Aug. 1864 to 5 Aug. 1865 (1 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

APPLEBEE, William S., Private, Co.I, 63rd Ohio Infantry, 2 June 1862 to 17 July 1865 (3 yr., 6 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Disability: Shot in left leg.

TAYLOR, Creed (CREED could be the last name) Private, Co. H, Missouri Infantry 27 Oct. 1863 to 2 Nov. 1865 (2 yr., 3 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

COPE, Samuel C., U. S. Soldier. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

JACKSON, Francis C., U. S. Soldier. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

ADAMS, John J., U. S. Soldier. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo., 8th Street.
