Persons who served in the Army, Navy, and Marine Corps of the United States during the war of the rebellion (who are survivors) and widows of such persons, in Montgomery Township, County of Montgomery, State of Missouri, enumerated in June, 1890. George Keadle, Enumerator.

MITCHELL, William L., Private, Missouri Infantry. P.O. Add: Montgomery Twsp, Mo. Remarks: I don't think he is entitled to a record.

MATTOCKS, (could be MATLOCK) Robert S., Private, Co. H, 12th Missouri Cavalry, 4 Jan. 1864 to 9 April 1866 (2 yr., 3 mo., 5 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Ruptured Sept 2, 1865 on Powder River, Dakotah.

RIENSCH, Chris, Private, Co. G, 18th Illinois Infantry, 7 Mar. 1865 to 6 Jan. 1866. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Typhoid pneumonia caused loss or injury of voice.

CLARE, Horatio C., 1st Lieutenant, Co. C, Missouri State Militia, Cavalry, Aug. 1861 to 1865. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Remarks: This is what he says.

WALLACE, James M., Private, Company F, 7th Missouri Cavalry, Nov. 1861 to Nov. 1863 (2 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Chronic diarrhea, feels the effects of it.

WALLACE, James M., Private, Company F, 7th Missouri Cavalry, Nov. 1863 to 1 Sept. 1865 (1 yr., 10 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Chronic diarrhea, feels the effects of it. (Same person as above)

KLINGLEHOEFER, Martin, Private, Co. I, 31st Missouri Infantry, 25 Aug. 1862 to 28 June 1865 (3 yr., 10 mo., 3 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Chronic diarrhea, and dropsy.

JOHNSON, Thomas M., Private, Co. I, 8th Missouri Infantry, 10 July 1861 to 14 July 1864 (3 yr., 4 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

JOHNSON, Thomas M., Sergeant, Co. K, 49th Missouri Infantry, 28 Oct. 1864 to 28 Oct. 1865. (1 yr.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. (Same person as above)

DAVIS, Isaac N., Private, Co. C, 9th Missouri Cavalry. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

STERGHT, Alice, Widow. GARTSIDE, Job, Corporal, Co. D, 124th Illinois Infantry, June 1862 to 1 Nov. 1864 (2 yr., 6 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Remarks: Died of chronic diarrhea at St. Louis in 1864.

DUFFY, Samuel L., 1st Pilot, Bragg, 20 Nov. 1861 to 12 Aug. 1865 (3 yr., 9 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Remarks: Drawing pension but cannot tell name of disability.

BAILEY, Emma, Widow. BAILEY, G.S. Private, Co. H, 38th Ohio Infantry, 26 Jan. 1864 to 15 May 1865 (1 yr., 3 mo., 17 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

PECK, Elisabeth, Widow. PECK, Adam M., 1863 to 1863 P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Remarks: Died in prison at Richmond. She can't give dates of enlistment or discharge.

STILL, John, Private, Co. I, 31st Missouri Infantry, July 1862 to Mar. 1863 (8 mo.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Disease of testicles from mumps.

BRANHAM, Benjamin, Private, Co. F, 7th Wisconsin Infantry, 1861 to 1864. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Chronic diarrhea.

BRANHAM, Benjamin, Banshee, 1864 to 1865. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Chronic diarrhea. (Same person as above)

TETTERMAN, Spencer, Private, Co. F, 47th Pennsylvania Infantry, 7 July 1861 to 19 Oct. 1863 (2 yr., 3 mo., 12 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Contracted chronic diarrhea in 1863.

TETTERMAN, Spencer, re-enlisted, 19 Oct. 1863 to 25 Dec. 1865 (2 yr., 2 mo., 6 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Contracted chronic diarrhea in 1863. (Same person as above)

KISER, Christian, Co. H, 6th Kansas Cavalry, 8 Jan. 1862 to 18 Mar. 1865 (3 yr., 2 mo., 10 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Shot in leg and is in bad health from pneumonia.

PEVELER, Jabez, Private, Co. B, 49th Missouri Infantry, 8 Aug. 1864 to 2 Aug. 1865 (11 mo., 24 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Chronic diarrhea.

SPENCER, James, Co. C, 9th Missouri State Militia, Cavalry, 1 Jan. 1862 to 17 Feb. 1864 (2 yr., 1 mo., 16 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

MITCHELL, Samuel S., Private, Co. G, 111th Illinois Infantry, 12 Aug. 1862 to 21 Feb. 1863 (5 mo., 9 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Dis: Hernia of the right from lifting in service.

MAHONEY, Nathan, Private, Co. C, 9th Missouri State Militia, Cavalry, 20 Apr. 1863 to 7 Feb. 1864 (9 mo., 13 da.) P.O. Add: Wellsville, Mo. Remarks: Discharged by General Order.

HANCOCK, Thornton (?), Private, Company A, 49th Missouri Infantry, 8 Aug. 1864 to 1865. P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Remarks: Discharged by General Order.

PHILIPS, Francis M., Private, Co. I, 7th Missouri Cavalry, 5 Jan. 1862 to 17 Oct. 1864. (2 yr., 8 mo., 12 da.) P.O. Add: Wellsville, Mo.

UPDYKE, James E., Private, Co. A, 136th Pennsylvania Infantry, Aug. 1861 to Apr. 1862. P.O. Add: Wellsville, Mo. Remarks: Mustered out at close of war, dates given from memory.

UPDYKE, James E., Private, Co.L, 1st New York Artillery, 14 Sept. 1864 to 17 June 1865 (9 mo., 3 da.) P.O. Add: Wellsville, Mo. Remarks: Mustered out at close of war, dates given from memory. (Same person as above)

POLSTON, Andrew, Private, Co. F, 24th Missouri Infantry, 12 Aug. 1861 to 15 Oct. 1864 (3 yr., 2 mo., 3 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo., Remarks: Discharged at expiration of term of service. Sunstroke.

KEADLE, George, Private, Co. E, 62nd Ohio Infantry, 21 Oct. 1861 to 24 June 1864 (2 yr., 9 mo., 27 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Remarks: Discharged for disability.

MAHONEY, Christopher, Private, Co. F, 24th Missouri Infantry, 1 Feb. 1862 to 27 Jan. 1863 (11 mo., 27 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo.

FEMMER, August, Private, 12 Sept. 1863 to 19 Oct. 1865 (2 yr., 1 mo., 7 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Remarks: Discharged by General Order.

FEMMER, Frederick, Private, 12 Sept. 1863 to 19 Oct. 1865 (2 yr., 1 mo., 7 da.) P.O. Add: Montgomery City, Mo. Remarks: Discharged by General Order.

HEYING, Lawrence, P.O. Add: Montgomery Township.
